
Towards a monographic treatment of the family Musaceae in Cambodia, Laos and Vietnam

Résumé

A preliminary taxonomic revision of the species of Musaceae in Cambodia, Laos and Vietnam is presented, treating the sole species of the monotypic genus *Musella*, two species of *Ensete*, and twelve species and one variety of *Musa*. Typifications of the endemic species of this region are discussed, and preliminary conservation assessments are provided for all species. A new species, *Musa haekkinenii* N.S. Lý & Haev., was published in 2012, and *Ensete leongkietii* Luu, N.L. Vu & Q.D. Nguyen from Vietnam is placed in synonymy under *E. superbum* (Roxb.) Cheesman.
